TCC's Board of Trustees has a new chairman. He's Dr. Dewey H. Tuggle, Jr., a Tacoma dentist. Dr. Tuggle, who was appointed to the Board in 1969, was elected March 23 to succeed Robert Yamashita. Donald E. Anderson was elected vice chairman. Both Dr. Tuggle and Anderson will serve from April 4 to June 30, 1973. Board actions included recognition of the Tacoma Community College Federation of Teachers as the official representative of academic employees (TCCFT won the bargaining election March 16 with 111 votes to 54 for the Tacoma Community College Association). . . granting of tenure to six faculty members -- Richard C. Spangler, Mrs. Clara M. Cox, Mrs. Georgia McDade, Dr. Dale Potter, Mrs. Carole Steadman and Frank Weihs . . . and approval of a \$10,300 low bid to install lighting in the college's new parking lots.
