Snow is a Four-letter Word

The worst blizzard to hit Tacoma since 1950 forced TCC to close for two days Jan. 25 and 26. A commuter college can scarcely operate without its parking lots, and the drifts were as high as four feet in places. It cost about \$800 in rental of snow removal equipment to get the campus back into operation.

Credit Enrollment Tops 3,800

More than 3,800 persons have signed up for credit classes this winter. In addition, some 1,000 persons are taking non-credit community service classes at TCC. Joe Kosai, records and admissions officer, said the number of full-time students (those registered for 12 or more credits) is 2,288.
